ASU Art Museum Coloring Book

Make your own coloring book! Coloring is a fun way to relax and express your artistic self. This activity lets you make your own book filled with illustrations of things found at ASU Art Museum. All of which you can color in! The illustrations give you a sneak peak of the ASU Art Museum's architecture, ceramics collection, location and galleries.

Materials:

- Colored pencils or markers.
- String or ribbon.
- Paper.
- Paper-clip.
- Scissors.
- Printer.



How to:

1. Gather your materials.
2. Print the ASU Art Museum coloring sheets out. Make sure to print them double sided!
3. Now fold each coloring sheet in half hamburger style.
4. Take each folded sheet and using a paper-clip poke a hole on each of the black dots that are on the fold of the coloring sheet.
5. Once all the sheets are folded, insert them inside of each other so that all the folded edges are lined up.
6. Set the sheets aside and cut your string or ribbon into two strips about six inches long.
7. With one of the pieces of string put it through the top hole on all of the sheets. Then put it back out through the hole right below it. Tie the loose ends in a bow! make sure it isn't too tight or else the paper will crinkle.
8. Repeat step seven with your second piece of string and the bottom two holes.
9. Now you're ready to color in your book! Color in the pictures however you want, inside or outside the lines. Be creative and have fun!
